

Information on the

Request for Admission to the

First Module Examination / Overall Examination

A written application for admission to the first Module Examination / Overall Examination must be submitted to the Examination Board **before** the first electronic registration for module examinations. The deadline for submitting the application (cut-off deadline) is published in the Study and Deadline Calendar of the Faculty of Catholic Theology.

If you do not submit the application in time, you will not be able to register for any examination.

The following documents* are required:

1. **A written informal application** to the Examination Board (including date and signature) with the **confirmation** (see Item 4). You may also use the template available under “Forms & Information Sheets” on the Examination Office website.
2. **A certificate of general or subject-specific higher education entrance qualification**, or an equivalent credential.
3. **A certificate of enrolment** as proof of your registration as a regular student in the degree program “Catholic Theology” at the University of Bonn, or proof of admission as a secondary auditor pursuant to § 52 HG.
4. **A confirmation** stating that there is no examination (including the final examination) in a degree program with substantial similarities in content with the degree program Catholic Theology leading to the above mentioned degree that you have failed at your final attempt and that, at the time of registering for a module examination, you are not registered for another examination procedure whose result would have to count toward the module examination being requested.

* Please submit the documents as an officially certified copy.

If you present an original or an officially certified copy together with a simple (uncertified) copy during office hours, the original or certified copy can be returned to you.
